Every two years a work party travels to Kenya to work alongside the local people in one or two of the projects supported by Karibuni. After work you will stay either in a church guest house in Nairobi, or in the homes of local church members; either way you will experience warm Kenyan hospitality and friendship. African music and songs, with more warm fellowship and a real welcome.
