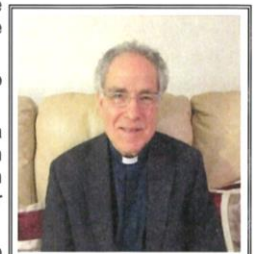
His first appointment as a Minister was to the Salisbury Circuit. It was here that his children, Richard and Ruth, were born.
