- Haddenham Methodist Church
- St Andrew's Anglican Church
- St Andrew's School (Chinnor) Tuck Shop

Providing info on the Website and articles in the Circuit magazine

Pending activities include:

- providing stalls or items for Christmas Fayres and events
- preparing and distributing catalogues

Reminder for circuit members to:

- promote/ make available Fairtrade goods at their church and events
- maintain Fairtrade as an agenda item at their Church Council meetings.
- self monitor the use of Fairtrade products to maintain the Circuits statement that it is a Fairtrade circuit.
- recognise Fairtrade is a policy and informs practice on how items are produced.
- consider what impact there would be if each person purchased one fair trade item in their weekly shop (look for items with a Fair trade symbol when doing your shops)

Current issues which raise issues relating to fair trading include:

- the vote to leave the EU -
- the impact on and variation in trading rules and currency exchange rates
- the impact of the implicit attitude of 'look after yourself'.
- debates on fair pay, anti-discrimination and slave labour
- how to promote wealth generation in all parts of the world

Offer to churches and individuals

- if you are holding an event, do consider promoting fairly traded.
- Items can be provided on a sale or return basis for events
- regular and occasional requests can be and are catered for. (free delivery)
